Fin Greenall is an enthusiast. Rather more so than you might expect, in fact, from someone with more than ten albums under their belt. This is someone who's lived a life-and-a-half of hard graft and hard gigging in electronic, acoustic and even pop music already - that enthusiasm bubbles like someone half his age discovering the buzz of musical and cultural engagement for the first time.

Fin, currently a Berlin resident, was born in Cornwall but found himself growing up in 80's Bristol, in the midst of it's famous cultural explosion. "It was an epic place to grow up," Fin says. "The Rare Groove revival, the outdoor rave scene, pirate radio - you'd see Massive Attack driving around, you'd see Tricky in the clubs, you'd have your mind blown by a DJ playing 'LF0' one moment then by seeing Horace Andy... I was skateboarding too, I was right IN it, and we were so, so proud to be from this place with its own thing".
