Einar comments on the Nordic Night on Borgholm: *"This is the first time we arrange Nordic Night in one of the Nordic countries and this time, we are fortunate to have the opportunity to include workshops and even a meet&greet session beside a wonderful support act: Mari Boine. This will add more context to our art and therefore potentially even more depth to the concert experience."*

The latest critically acclaimed, multi-chart success album «Kvittravn» (White Raven) continues where the Runaljod trilogy left off, yet it marks a distinct evolution in our sound. The album features a broad selection of both traditional and historical instruments such as

Kravik-lyre, Trossingen-lyre, Taglharpa, Sotharpa, Langeleik, Crwth, Goat-horn, Lur, Bronze-lur, flute, the Moraharpa. The record also features guest appearances by a small group of prominent traditional singers, spearheaded by Kirsten Bråten Berg, one of the most important custodians of Norwegian traditional song. Throughout eleven songs, Kvitavn discusses Northern sorcery, spirit-animals, shadows, nature and animism, the wisdom and meanings of certain myths, various Norse spiritual concepts, and the relation between sage and songs.
