Olivia Dean today announces her spring 2024 UK and European headline tour. Dean will be touring her sensational live shows across some of the biggest venues she's ever played, including a huge London hometown show at Hammersmith's Eventim Apollo.

Of announcing her biggest tour to date, Olivia shares: "I can't wait to fill these rooms with love and warmth and dancing feet. It's gonna be very special and I can't wait to sing with you all".

Born and raised in Walthamstow, Olivia Dean is one the UK's brightest rising stars, praised for her endearing, down-to-earth lyrics and magnetic, feel-good live performances. To date, Dean has released her Mercury Prize shortlisted, #4 charting debut album *Messy*, three acclaimed EPs *Ok Love You Bye*, *What Am I Gonna Do On Sundays?* and *Growth* and in 2021 achieved her first top 20 single with her cover of 'The Christmas Song', recorded for Amazon Originals.

Since 2019 Olivia has been gathering fans apace, now with over 5 million monthly listeners globally, and she was streamed over 150 million times in 2022 alone. She has supporters across BBC Radio 1, Beats 1, The Guardian, Sunday Times Style, Dazed, The FADER, NME, ELLE, gal-dem, Vanity Fair, Clash and more tipping her for greatness. She has become a regular feature at fashion week, and is an ambassador for Chanel.

During the pandemic, Dean connected with fans by performing from the side of her bright yellow truck, which she toured in offering free shows to communities around the UK. Her first official gig back at the Camden Jazz Cafe sold out instantly and went on to be watched over 7 million times after it went viral on Tiktok. Dean has gone on to sell out venues including The Roundhouse and Somerset House and has played festivals worldwide including Glastonbury, Montreux Jazz festival and many more.
