Tora are a 4-piece Indie Electronic band originating from Byron Bay, Australia. The name Tora is derived from the Greek word $\tau\omega\rho\alpha$ meaning now.

Having met in primary school and played in various high school bands together over the years, Jo Loewenthal (Vocal/Guitar), Shaun Johnston (Bass), Jai Piccone (Vocal / Keys) and Thorne Davis (Drums) eventually formed Tora in 2013.

Best known for their songs 'Too Much' & 'Inundated' Tora make a unique blend of live instruments with quirky electronic production, resulting in a polished authentic sound attracting listeners around the globe.

With a music career inspired by the tragic death of his music mentor / brother in law at age 13, frontman Jo Loewenthal found songwriting as a way process his emotions and overcome the challenges that life bring. Influenced by artists like John Mayer, James Blake, Little Dragon, Red Hot Chili Peppers & Foals, Tora's sound is broad and eclectic exploring many genres and vibes throughout the catalogue.
